**July 23, 1893<sup>1</sup>** in Borup Hede, Vrå Sogn, Børglum Herred. She was baptized September 3, 1893, in Vrå, Hjørring, Denmark. Witnesses to the baptized were Christian Mørk Nikolajsen, Marinus Steffensen, Christen Møller and Anna Kirsten Mølle.<sup>2</sup>

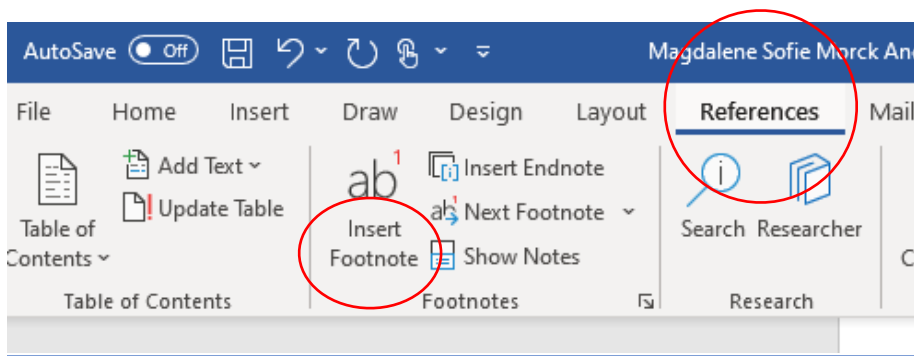

## Siblings <sup>4</sup>

1. Laurine Kristine: May 30, 1886<sup>5</sup> – July 30, 1976. always known as Kristine or Christine. In the 1890 Denmark Census, Laurine is listed with the family as living in Vrå. **In 1904 she immigrated to Goodlands, Manitoba or she immigrated in 1905, leaving Liverpool, England on March 21, 1905, on the ship Lake Champlain, destined for St. John, New Brunswick, Canada.**<sup>6</sup> She married Niels Peter Jensen (born 1875 in Vraa) on December 24 or 26, 1905.<sup>7</sup>

2. Lars Kristian: March 13, 1888 – July 23, 1969: changed name to when he moved to Canada, where he moved in 1906<sup>8</sup>. In 1890, he with the family in Vrå. Married Inger Kristine (Christine) Jensine Christensen (September 9, 1887 – August 26, 1967) on November She had immigrated November 18, 1908, to Goodlands from Hørmested, Hjørring. Prior to 1913 they moved to Saskatchewan to partnership with Chris' brother Marius, who returned to Denmark to family farm.<sup>9</sup>

4. Marius Julius: October 28, 1890 – December 26, 1971): He was in Vrå on October 2, 1904. He then immigrated in 1906 to

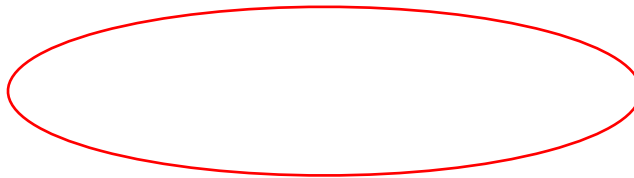

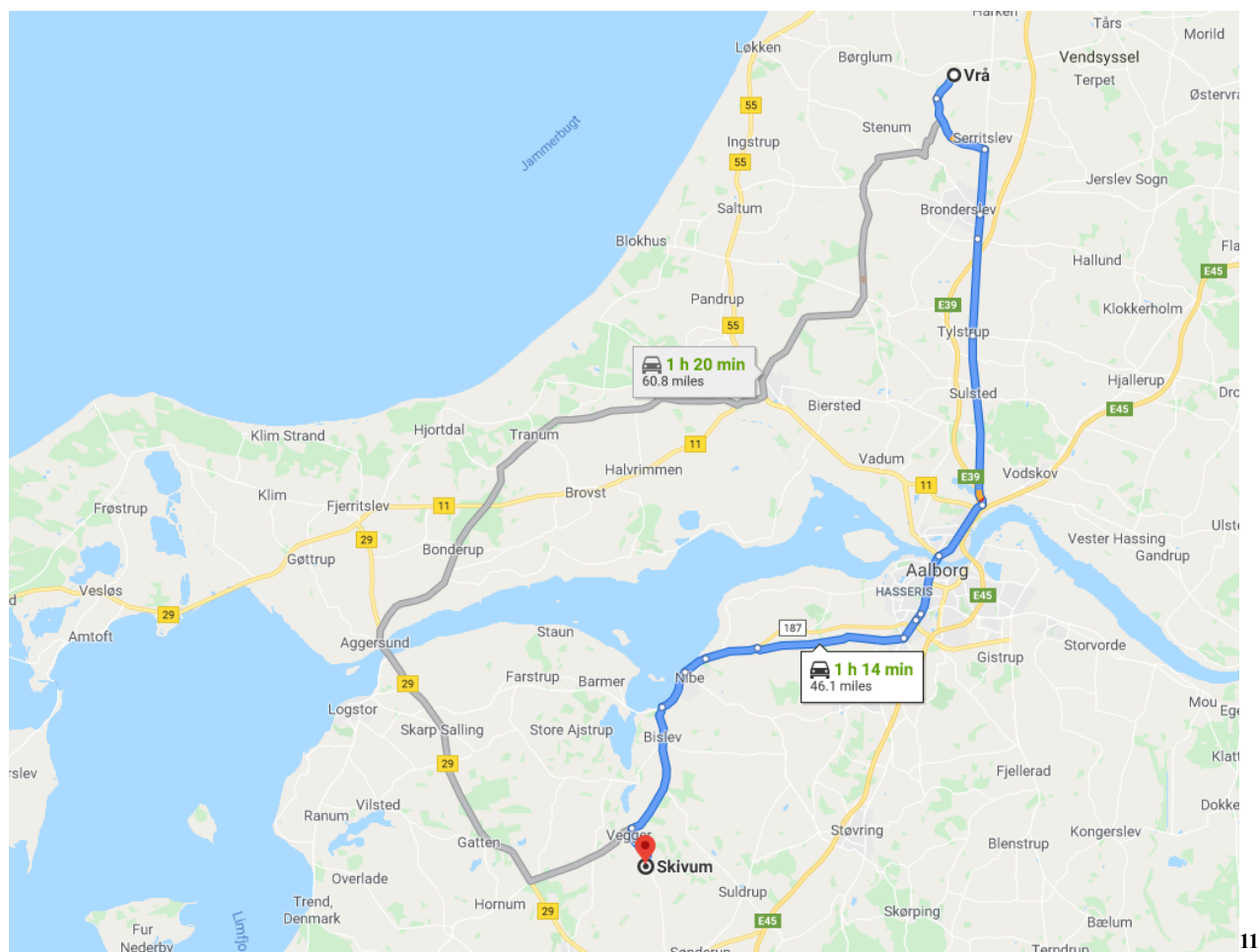

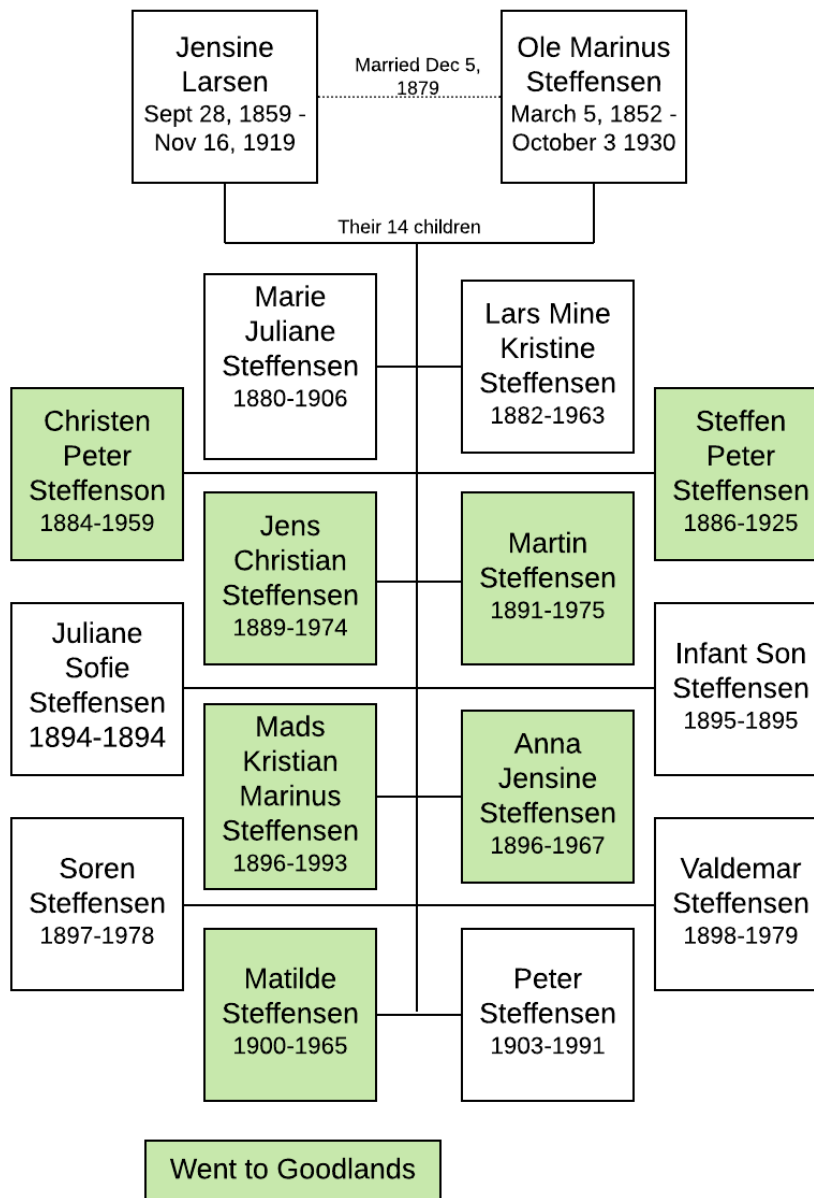
